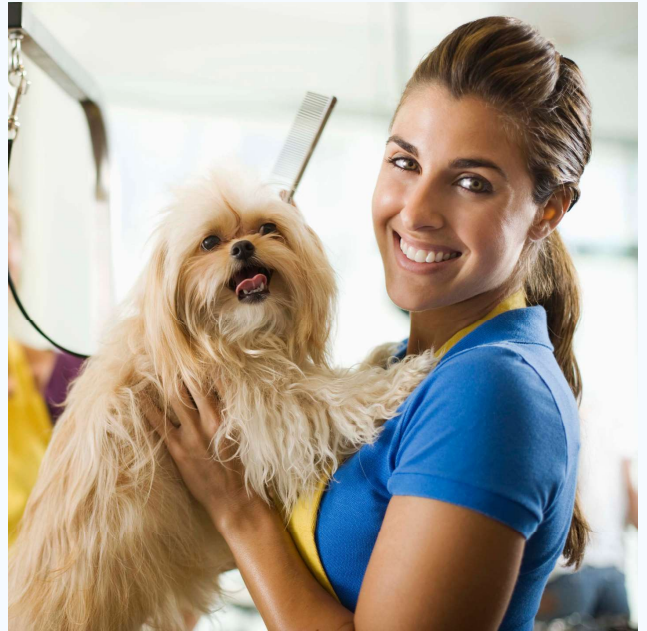

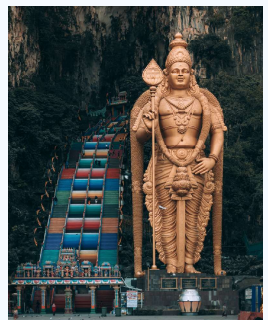
## CAREER & TRAVEL

From 1st January 2023, if you are an Australian Qualified Veterinary Nurse you can migrate to Australia under the new Short Term Skilled Occupation List (STSOL) fast track migration pathway

The Australia Government recently released the new Short Term Skilled Occupation List (STSOL) that allows fast track migration to Australia for qualified Vet Nurses to Australia

Vet Nursing is a specific industry segment that the Australian government has identified as having a high demand for graduates in. Due to this high demand a qualified VET Nurse graduate can apply to fast track their migration to Australia

Completing our Vet Nursing Program then you qualify for fast track migration process under STSOL to Australia
