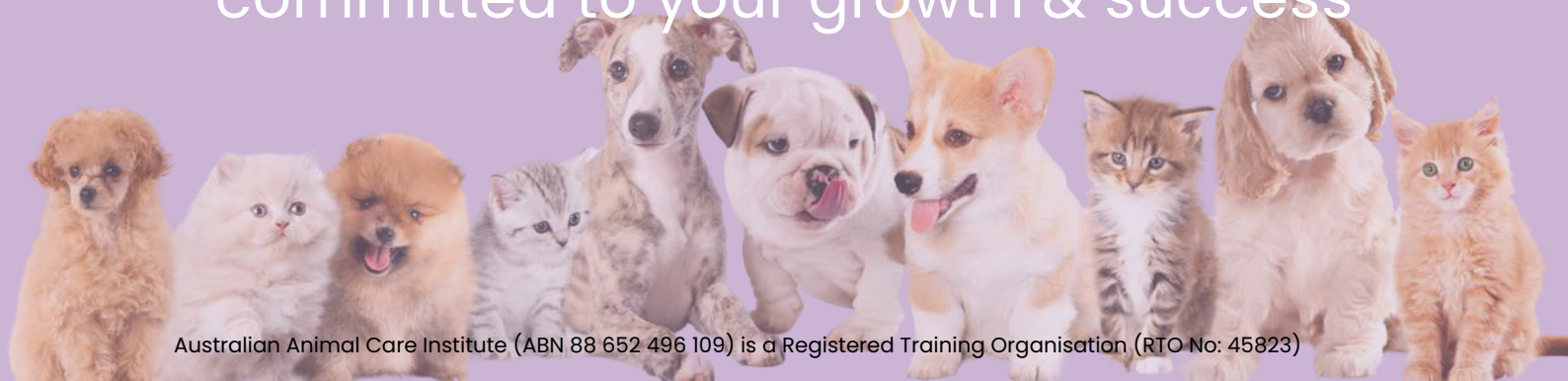

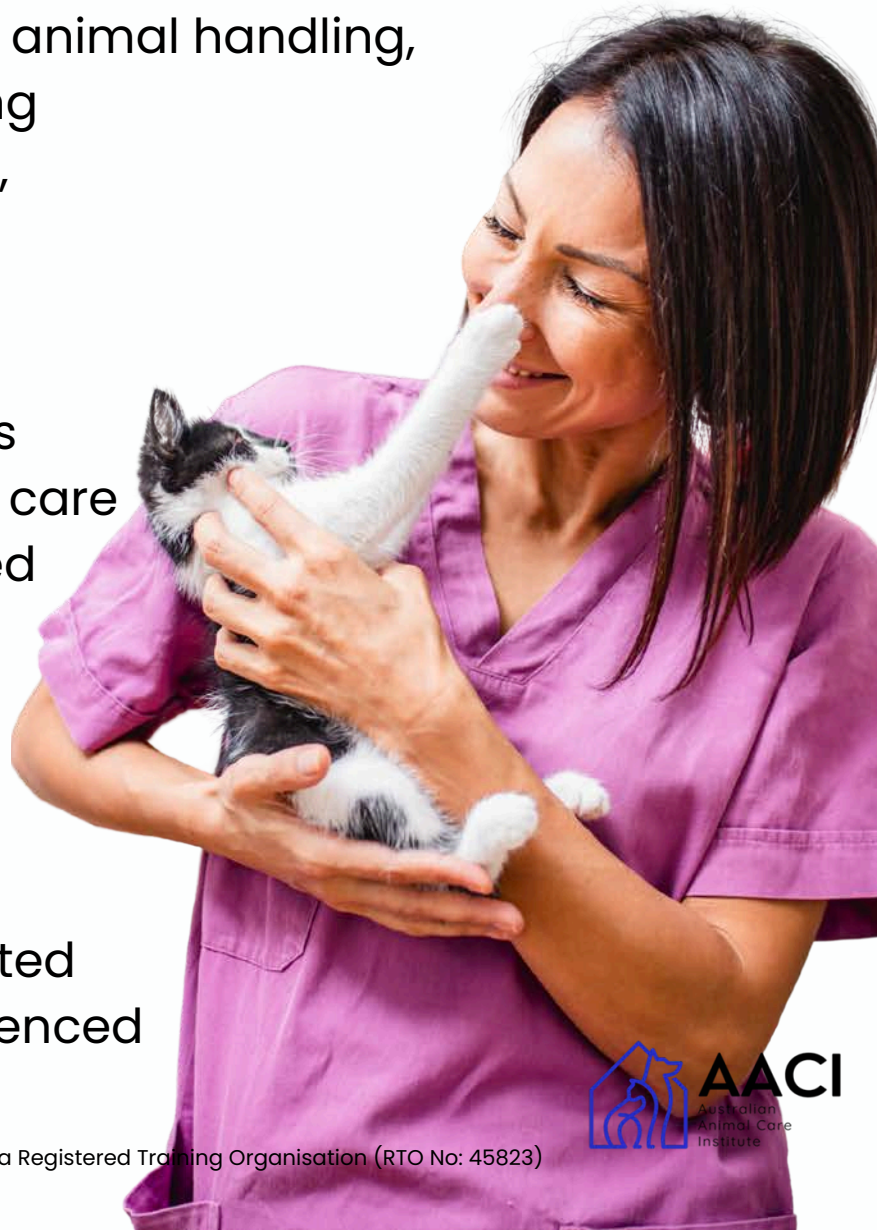
All assessments meet national training package requirements and ASQA standards, while remaining flexible and supportive for online learners

Assessment may include:

- Short-answer questions and simple scenarios
- Practical tasks related to animal handling, care, hygiene, and feeding
- Evidence such as photos, videos, or workplace observations

Some practical assessments require access to an animal care environment. There is no fixed minimum number of placement hours, however all required assessment tasks must be completed

All assessments are conducted by qualified, industry-experienced trainers and assessors

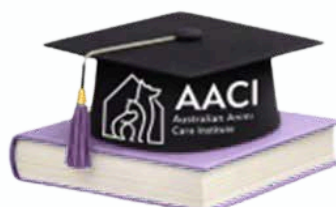
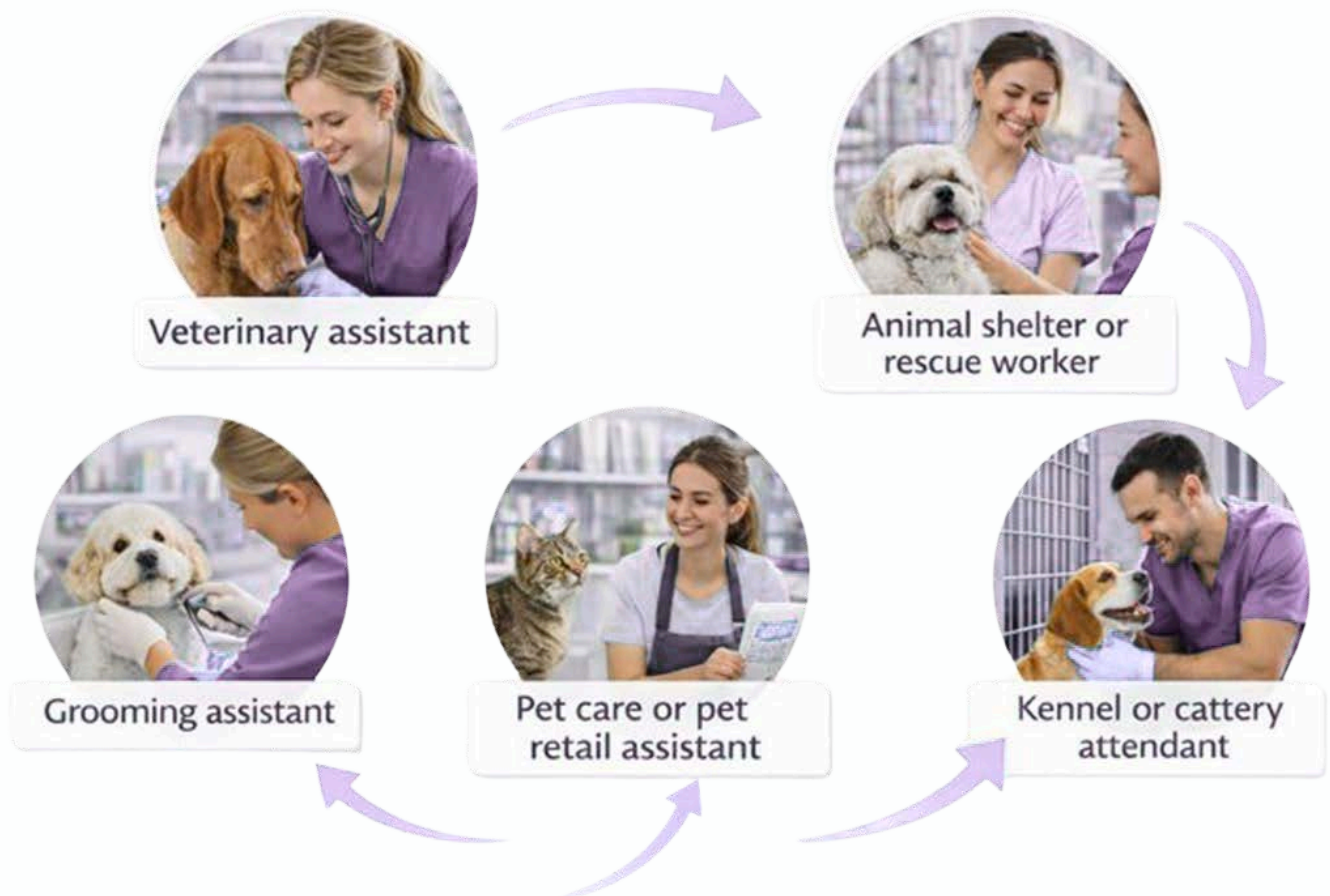
